

PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION
NOVEMBER 4, 2008

The Presidential Election, legally warned, was held on November 4, 2008, at the Deep River Library from 6 a.m. until 8 p.m. Nancy Talbot served as Moderator. A total of 2,693 votes were cast including , 190 by absentee ballot, and 43 by Presidential Ballot. Registered voters on the November 4, 2008, list totaled 3,251. Voter turnout was 83%.
