

SPECIAL STATE ELECTION
FEBRUARY 22, 2011

The Special State Election, legally warned, was held on February 22, 2011, in the Deep River Library Community Room from 6 a.m. until 8 p.m. Bruce E. Edgerton served as Head Moderator. A total of 972 votes were cast--903 at the polls and 69 by absentee ballot. Registered voters on the February 18, 2011 list totaled 3,151. Voter turnout was 30%. The voters were registered as follows:

The purpose of this Special State Election was to fill the seat for State Representative vacated by James Field Spallone who accepted the position of Deputy to Secretary of the State, Denise Merrill. The following votes were cast. An asterisk follows the name of the official seated.
