RECREATIONAL BASKETBALL FOR KIDS IN GRADES K – 1

- ❖ The K-1st grade boys & girls will have a clinic for **one hour per week** after school designed for introductory skills development.
- ❖ Children will be taught the basic motor skills necessary to play organized basketball.
- ❖ Focus will be on Skills development in dribbling, passing, and shooting.
- ❖ Focus will also be on having fun!
- ❖ The K-1 grade boys & girls will be grouped together and divided weekly into smaller groups to focus on skills.
- ❖ Grades K through 1 will use a junior size 5 ball.
- ❖ All sessions will be held at DRES
- ❖ Sessions will begin the week of January 9, 2017. Day to be determined.
- ❖ The program will run for 6 weeks ending the week of February 13, 2017.
