Camp Counselor-in-Training (CITs): Position requires working closely with campers to insure that their camp experience is fun, rewarding and safe. CIT's might be required to attend weekly field trips and are expected to participate in all camp activities. Ideal candidates will have previous camp experience and be at least entering the 9th grade. CIT positions are not paid. Preference will be given to Deep River Residents.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENT AND INFORMATION

The Summer Program is in session from June 20- August 12. All staff must attend a 3-hour training session prior to the start of camp. All tax forms/applications/personal information forms must be on file prior to the first day of camp. Staff must arrive at the Deep River Elementary School/Plattwood Park **no later** than 8:15 am unless scheduled to work pre-camp care. Employees are responsible for the care, proper use and storage of equipment, games, etc. All staff is required to sign in and out daily. Daily staff meetings will be held when necessary.

All staff is expected to be positive role models for the campers and participate in the daily camp activities. Staff is also expected to contribute program ideas, be flexible, be in good spirits, have patience, display fairness, be on time, be willing to help with clean-up duties when needed and abide by the rules and regulations set forth in the counselor handbook.
