The Conservation and Inland Wetlands Commission held a site walk on the property of Incarnation Camp, 253 Bushy Hill Road, at 8:30 a.m.

Absent: Alan Mizejeski.

Also present: Nancy Howard (Commission Clerk) and the following representatives of Incarnation Camp: Nancy Pilon, Executive Director, Paul Torcellini (builder), Steve Arthur, Property Services Director. The architect, Duo Dickinson, was present only at the beginning of the walk.

Commission members inspected the property in connection with the proposal for construction of an open air chapel by the lake. Mr. Torcellini identified the location of the proposed chapel. The closest column is approximately 22-23 feet from the lake. Revised plans dated January 12, 2012 have been prepared by Duo Dickinson to address some of the issues raised at the initial meeting.
