A **regular meeting** of the *Deep River Conservation and Inland Wetlands Commission* held on Thursday, October 11, 2012 at the Deep River Town Hall was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Chairman Mizejeski. Members present: Susan Board, John Dube, Ron Larsen, Carol Libby, Alan Mizejeski, Michael Tomlinson, and Alternate Tanner Steeves. Absent: George Atwood and Alternate/WEO Mark Reyher Also present: Nancy Howard. The Chairman seated Alternate Tanner Steeves for the absent member.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Mike Tomlinson and seconded by Ron Larsen to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of September 13, 2012 as printed. (7-0) Voted Unanimously.

Public Business: None

Enforcement: Richard Cooke, 215 Winthrop Road: Ron Larsen, Alan Mizejeski and Mark Reyher met at the site a couple weeks ago to review the activity taking place with possible concern regarding stock piling near the southwest corner. The stock pile area was full and was turning back toward the pond. A trench has been dug to divert the water towards Route 80 and around. A second trench was recommended to pick up the overflow. Ron Larsen noted that he checked the water in the stream all the way to Plattwood and the water is clean. Bob Doane has met with the operator. The work is proceeding.

Report on Finances/Payment of Bills: The following bills were received: Nancy Howard, clerical services, 12 hours; Hartford Courant, legal advertising, \$43.56. A motion was made by Carol Libby and seconded by Ron Larsen to approve payment of the bills as submitted. (7-0) Voted Unanimously.

Report by Chairman: Chairman Mizejeski reviewed information and survey received regarding the Connecticut Environmental Review Teams who perform natural resource inventories for specific land use projects. Tanner Steeves will obtain further information.

Correspondence: A Freedom of Information workshop will be held on October 25, 2012 at the Chester Meeting House at 7:00 p.m.

Regulation Amendments: Members reviewed and discussed the proposed amendments to the Regulations received from the State DEEP. The State model regulations will be reviewed and additional discussion will take place at future meetings.

Conservation: After the last regular meeting, Mark Reyher was going to speak with the First Selectman about splitting the Commission. Additional discussion will take place at the next meeting. Members discussed attending meetings of Conservation Commissions in area towns to observe their meetings.

A motion was made by Susan Board and seconded by Ron Larsen to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 p.m. (6-0) Voted Unanimously.
